Essential Questions

- What is a medicine, what is the difference between a prescription medicine and over the counter medicine?
- What are the effects of tobacco on personal hygiene, and health?

Big Ideas

- The use of alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs in unsafe ways is harmful to one's health.

Lesson Plan: Gun Safety

Second Grade

2.3.2.PS.2 Discuss healthy and safe choices both indoor and outdoors (e.g., using equipment, wearing bike helmets, vehicle, water, weather safety).

2.3.2.PS.3 Recognize and demonstrate safety strategies to prevent injuries at home, school, in the community (e.g., traffic safety, bicycle/scooter safety, fire safety, poison safety, accident prevention)

Duration: 30-45 minutes

Objectives:

1. Students will be introduced to who has guns.
2. Students will understand the dangers of mishandling firearms.
3. Students will learn about gun safety rules.
4. Students will learn how to respond in situations where they encounter a gun.
5. Students will perform role plays involving situations where someone is trying to show them a gun.
6. Take-Home Letter about gun safety and storage.

Method:

 - a. People who own guns
 - b. Gun Safety Rules
 - i. Recite Response of what to do should they find themselves in the presence of a gun.
2. Watch McGruff Video on Gun Safety: [Not Cool, Kyle](#)
 - a. Answer questions pertaining to video.
3. Movement Game
 - a. Circle chant hand game
4. Puzzle Game
 - a. Finish Words by filling in the blanks
5. Role Play exercise: Practice what to do in a scenario
 - i. A friend brings a gun to school and shows it to you. How do you respond?
 - ii. A friend or relative wants to show you their parent's gun. How do you respond?
6. Discuss Take-Home Letter about gun safety and storage.
