## INTERGRATING 21<sup>ST</sup> CENTURY THEMES & SKILLS

As today's students enter into an increasingly global economy, it is important that they have a diverse range of skills to succeed. The Partnership for 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills, a national organization that advocates for 21<sup>st</sup> century readiness for every student, has developed a Framework for 21<sup>st</sup> Century Learning. This document fuses the traditional 3Rs of Reading, wRiting and aRithmetic.

Teachers will easily be able to integrate 21<sup>st</sup> Century skills into daily instruction through the following framework:

- Build thematic instruction based up real-world tasks and authentic sources
- Instruction is learner-centered; students take responsibility for the learning and creation of new content.
- Technology is integrated with instruction and assessment to support and enhance learning
- Instruction and assessment and differentiated to meet the needs of individual learners.
- Assessment is focused on what students can do; students know what they will be asked to do and how they will be assessed.
- Instruction and assessment focuses on the comparisons between the products, practices, and perspectives of the target skills and concepts.
- Students explore opportunities to use content related skills outside of the classroom.
