<u>Geography Elective</u> Text: *Exploring Our World: People Places and Cultures*, Glencoe

Course Description (via outline): Students began with creating a World Map of the continents, oceans, the equator, and prime meridian. They do a project on the continents where they learn the countries and review maps of the continents following the project. They also include landforms on the project. It is a group encyclopedia on a continent and each word must include a map. Each group teaches the class about their continent. Those topics on the elective sheet are covered within the group project about the continent.

The course closes by studying the United States, learning the capitals, their locations, and region. They create map of the U.S. as they learn about the states and landforms.
