Video Tech Elective

Course Description: Create, edit, and present audio and video using a variety of software and other multimedia tools.

Audacity

<u>Week 1-2</u>: Learn to use the program Audacity by exploring the different tools available. This will be done through practice sounds, files, videos, etc.

Week 3-5: Students will create a podcast about Bullying using Audacity.

<u>Week 6-7</u>: Enter "Six Sounds in Search of an Author Contest" by creating a 1 minute audio story to be entered. Reduce or extend time as needed based on deadlines.

Windows Movie Maker

<u>Week 8-9:</u> Learn how to use *Windows Movie Maker* by capturing, saving, and sending videos. <u>Week 10-12:</u> Students will create a digital flipbook using Windows Movie Maker.

Fundamentals of Video Production

Week 13: Learn how to use a camcorder

<u>Week 14:</u> Learn different shot techniques and understand roles of production crew <u>Week 15-16:</u> Create a storyboard and script. Participate in filming, editing, and evaluating video production

Major Activity: Character Education Video

<u>Week 17-20:</u> Students will break into groups and create a Character Education video utilizing the tools and software they learned about and practiced with over the course of the semester.

Grade assignments, final grade is pass/fail.
