

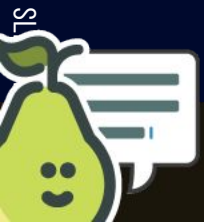

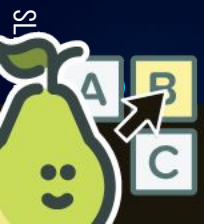

On a scale of 1-10 (10 being most likely) – how likely are you to get involved in a conflict if you feel very strongly about the topic?

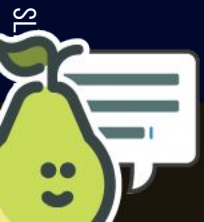

Strategies to Solve Conflict

Stay Calm

Don't let your emotions get the best of you.

State and Understand the Problem

Clearly explain what is wrong and how you may have been wronged.

Apologize

Whether you are right or wrong, start with an apology.

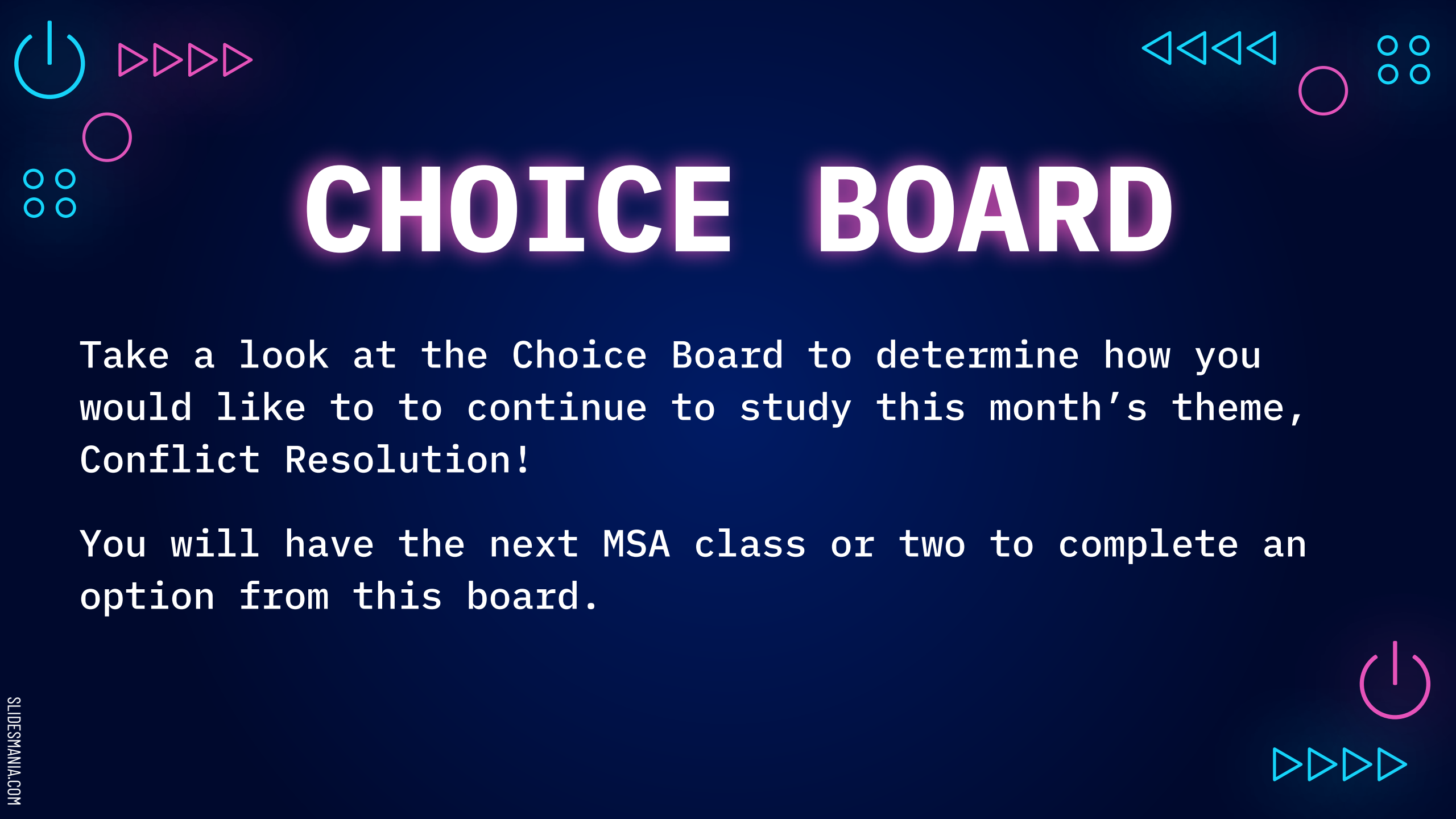
Find a Solution

Offer ideas on how to resolve the conflict.

Follow Up

If you think you've found a solution, check back in to be sure all parties involved continue to have the same understanding that you do.
