Upstander

An upstander is someone who chooses to support a person who is being abused or harmed. There are ways you can be an upstander online while keeping yourself safe. In short: If you choose to support someone who's being bullied or abused online, you've chosen to be an upstander.

Bystander

A person who is standing near and watching something that is happening but is not taking part in it.

HIB – When, Where & What

HIB stands for HARASSMENT, INTIMIDATION, and BULLYING. Any gesture, written, verbal, or physical act or electronic communication that takes place on school property, at a school sponsored function or school bus
