Handwriting and Spelling

Handwriting:

Introduce all of the cursive letters using the Fountas & Pinnell Word Work Lessons. Letters are grouped according to similarities in how they are formed. After introducing the letters and practicing them, model how to connect letters.

Spelling:

Spelling words taken from the Fountas & Pinnell High-Frequency Word List for Grade 4. Spelling Notebooks are used for in-class practice. One formal 20-word spelling test will be given at the end of this unit. (Two formal spelling tests will be given each marking period. Writing rubrics also assess spelling.)
