Student-Generated Questions

Students can work in groups on assignments to check each other's answers and correct each other. Students will complete "Stuck Wall". This is where students write on a sticky note what "stuck" with them and what they are "stuck" on.

Sage and Scribe

One question for two people, where one explains how to do the problem and the other person writes it and has to follow the directions. The person working on the question will take criticism and encouragement from the other person.

Math Wars

Whole class is given the same question to solve and a timer is set. When the timer goes off a spinner is used to determine who will answer the question in a certain seat. Another spinner is to determine which group will answer. Since students don't know who will be responsible for answering the question or if their group will be picked, they must work together.
