Extension Activities:

Student-Generated Questions

Pause at the end of the selection and ask students to reflect in silence and consider three questions they have about the selection. Then, have them jot their questions on a self-stick note and/or share with a partner.

Slideshow Projects

Students can create slideshows using information from the text. Showing understanding of the information that was taught by gathering pictures and data to represent the topic. Students can present their slideshows once finished.

Map Activities Students will explore and analyze maps to make predictions, generalizations, and answer questions.
