





## Observation game



Model the exercise with a students about finding our differences and finding our similarities. For example, "We are the same because we are both wearing blue shoes."

We are different because our eyes are different colors. Give students examples of ways they could be the same and different: hair color, hair length, clothes, shoes, eyes, height, names start with same letter, grade, age.

Now, pair up students, have them sit face to face. Give them a few minutes to discuss how they are the same and how they are different.

Each pair will then get to share in front of the class one way they are different and one way they are the same. You can follow up this activity with the same and different worksheet.


