- First and Second Declension Adjectives
- Agreement of Nouns and Adjectives, the Present Passive of 1st/2nd Conjugation Verbs
- Infinitives (Present)
- Second Declension -er Nouns, irregular Verbs (Sum and Possum Present tense)
- Complimentary infinitives

Readings include:

- Cicero, "The Deserter Wants a Reward"
- Cicero, "Cicero Writes to Terentia"
- Caesar, "The Druids"

Cultural topics will include:

- Roman valor and military life
- Roman epistulary style/content and a focus on Marriage
- "Barbarian" peoples and the Roman understanding of their religious customs
- Caesar and Cicero (their general influence on Roman culture/history)
