Score 2 Success with simpler content—vocabulary, foundational skills	The student will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • recognize/translate location and transportation vocabulary at the word level • produce memorized phrases and responses to prompts • respond to high-frequency, highly practiced, memorized questions associated with the vocabulary using memorized and high-frequency responses Student makes no major errors or omissions regarding the score 2 content
Score 1 Partial success with help	With help, student achieves partial success at score 2 content and/or score 3 content
Score 0 No success even with help	Even with help, no success

The novice-high language learner can understand and communicate using simple sentences, words and lists about familiar contexts related to daily, personal life. The Novice-high learner uses and relies on mostly basic, memorized questions, phrases and expressions that are high-frequency and highly practiced but is beginning to recombine and recognized memorized chunks to create with the language to express ideas and state needs.
