The student will perform basic skills or process, such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take various types of Composition photos. • Learning the basic fundamentals of photo types. • To determine what type of photo that was taken in their magazines. Student makes no major errors or omissions regarding the score 2 content
