## **General Overview, Course Description or Course Philosophy**

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### UNIT OVERVIEW

By evaluating choral performances within the defined parameters of a given rubric, students will improve their personal performance skills.

## **OBJECTIVES, ESSENTIAL QUESTIONS, ENDURING UNDERSTANDINGS**

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### OBJECTIVE

Students will understand that the quality and effectiveness of their own and others' performances can be evaluated using a given rubric.

### ESSENTIAL QUESTION

How do musicians improve the quality of their performance?

### ENDURING UNDERSTANDING

To express their musical ideas, musicians analyze, evaluate and refine their performance over time through openness to new ideas, persistence and the application of appropriate criteria.

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Students will use a rubric to submit formal evaluations of performances, both personal and watched.
