General Overview, Course Description or Course Philosophy

This is an introductory Spanish course. It introduces the students to the basics of the Spanish language through the discovery of various Spanish-speaking cultures around the world. The units in this course include the alphabet, the days of the week, the months of the year, the seasons, geography of the Spanish-speaking countries, the numbers, dates, time, activities, descriptions, school, clothing, professions and places. Students will learn how to ask questions in Spanish, as well as how to form sentences to answer questions in Spanish. This course develops the eseential pieces of learning the beginning levels of a world language: reading, writing, listening and speaking. It also emphasize the three modes of communication: interpretive, interpretional and presentational. The course uses authentic materials to introduce these topics and allow the students to grow as Spanish speakers, readers, writers and listeners with a background knowledge of Hispanic cultures around the world.

OBJECTIVES, ESSENTIAL QUESTIONS, ENDURING UNDERSTANDINGS

Students will understand that:

- conjugating a verb means to manipulate the infinitive so that it agrees with the different possible subjects.
- one of the three types of regular verbs in Spanish is called an "AR" verb.

Essential questions:

- How do I conjugate an AR verb?
- How do I identify an AR verb in Spanish?
- What do I need to know in order to use the AR verbs to form sentences in Spanish?

Declarative Knowledge

Students will understand that:

- they can conjugate AR verbs to subject/verb agreement in Spanish sentences.
- Different verbs are needed to create complete sentences in Spanish.

Procedural Knowledge

Students will be able to:

- request and provide information by asking and answering simple, practiced questions, using memorized words and phrases with the Spanish AR verbs and question words.
- present basic personal information, interests, and activities using memorized words, phrases, and a few simple sentences using the AR verbs and question words in Spanish.
- copy/write words, phrases, or simple guided texts using the AR verbs and question words in Spanish.

Formative Assessments

- 1. Game: "Around the World" Students will receive a sentence. They will have to choose the correct vocabulary word to put in the sentence.
- 2. Games: Eggspert, Charades, Jeopardy, Hangman, Flyswatters-Recall the meanings of each verb and the conjugation of each verb.
- 3. Writing activity: Write a short story using the different "AR"verbs.
- 4. Game: "Los Puerquitos" using the AR verbs
- 5. Exit tickets: Conjugate various AR verbs and identify what the verbs mean in English.
- 6. Partner activity: Students practice answering and asking eachother questions in Spanish using the question words and various conjugations of AR verbs.
- 7. Exit ticket: Los interrogativos

Summative Assessments

- 1. PowerPoint project: Students will create PowerPoint using the "AR" verbs and creating sentences for each illustration selected.
- 2. Interactive project: Students will take photos using digital cameras or smartphones of friends and family doing different activities using the "AR" verbs. Students will describe what they are doing in each photo.
- 3. Quiz 1: Subject pronouns and AR verb conjugations
- 4. Quiz 2: Question words (los interrogativos)
