General Overview, Course Description or Course Philosophy

The Kinnelon School District Grade 9 Health Education Curriculum was designed with the goal of helping students to attain Health Literacy as they move forward through the complexities of the 21st century. "Healthy students are learners who are knowledgeable, productive, emotionally healthy, motivated, socially engaged and ready for the world beyond their own borders. As part of the state's initiative to prepare students to function optimally as global citizens and workers, the contemporary view of health and physical education focuses on taking responsibility for one's health through an active, healthy lifestyle that fosters a lifelong commitment to wellness" (NJSLS; CHPE; ASCD 2004).

OBJECTIVES, ESSENTIAL QUESTIONS, ENDURING UNDERSTANDINGS

Personal growth and development are lifelong processes of physical, behavioral, emotional and follows chronological benchmarks, however, individuals generally enjoy different activities and grow at different rates. In particular, puberty is a time of physical, hormonal, social and emotional change that can vary among young people of different cultures, nutritional diets and healthy or unhealthy lifestyles. An individual's actions, genetics and family history can play a significant role in a young person's growth and development (Adapted from 2020, NJSLS, Comprehensive HPE).

Students will explore the stages of development children experience from birth through age five including brain growth, language development and what shapes their view of right and wrong. Students will discuss conditions that influence growth and development and study classic theories of child development including Piaget, Freud and Erickson.
