General Overview, Course Description or Course Philosophy

This is an introductory Spanish 3 elementary course. The units include colors, days of the week, the months of the year, dates, numbers, expressing likes and dislikes, the parts of the body, farm animals, culture, and descriptions. Students will learn different Spanish vocabulary words. They will learn to answer questions in Spanish and write simple sentences. This course develops the essential pieces of learning a world language: reading, writing, listening and speaking. It also emphasizes the three modes of communication: interpretive, interpretive, and presentational.
