Unit Overview

This Unit will focus on expressing your feelings in American Sign Language. Students will learn vocabulary based on feelings and being able to use facial expression and body language to express that feeling. Students will learn the importance of facial expression and body language when signing. Students will learn to understand feeling words when someone else is signing about his or her feelings. Finally, advanced students should be able to have a conversation with someone talking about his or her feelings, why he or she feels a certain way, and/or asking how someone is and asking why that person feels a certain way.

Essential Questions

Why is facial expression important when signing how one feels?

Why is the motion (direction of the sign) important to do correctly?

How can body language portray meaning?

What should my eyebrows be doing when asking "How" and "Why" questions?
