Unit Overview

Students can identify and pronounce individual days of the week as well as all days of the week in order in Spanish.

The Novice-mid language learner understands and communicates at the word level and can independently identify and recognize memorized words and phrases that bring meaning to text. Through active listening, frequent repetition and practice, students develop a fundamental vocabulary that supports comprehension of new vocabulary in the context of numbers and counting to ten.

What are the Spanish days of the week?

What are the days of the week in order according to a Spanish calendar?
