Unit Overview

Students can apply knowledge of numbers 1-31, days, months, and birthday to creation of birth month calendar.

Through active listening, frequent repetition and practice, students develop a fundamental vocabulary that supports comprehension of new vocabulary in the context of the changing seasons and weather.
