# Phonics Unit 1(T1)- Grade 1

Content Area: Reading

Time Period: September
Length: All year

#### **Unit Overview**

These trimester units begin at your discretion in September and will continue through until about the end of October for the learning goal. The 2nd learning goal will extend from October until the end of Trimester 1 (December). Extend the time if students have not mastered the skills taught in these units. The skills covered are listed below:

### 1st Scale-Review of K

- Unit 1 (3 weeks): Review or teach letter names, keywords, sounds and lowercase letter formations of the letters a-z. Fundations procedures are taught.
- Unit 2 (2 weeks): Teach/review how to blend and read cvc words, sentence structure with capital letters in the beginning and periods at the end, spell trick words, continue to reinforce proper letter formation. Fundations procedures are taught.

## **2nd Scale-Begin to Introduce New Concepts**

- \*\* You will NOT complete this learning scale until sometime early Trimester 3\*\*
  - Unit 3 (2 weeks): Teach digraphs, read with accuracy & prosody, high frequency words.
  - Unit 4 (2 weeks): Teach bonus letters, read with accuracy & prosody, high frequency words.
  - Unit 5 (1 week): Teach the glued sounds am and an, decode nonsense words.
