Into Reading Module 4

Content Area: Reading
Course(s): Reading 2

Module Overview

This phonics module guides students through important spelling patterns and phonics rules related to inflectional suffixes and the role of consonant doubling. The module begins with a focus on suffixes –s, –es, and –ed, helping students recognize how these endings change word meaning and tense. Spelling and handwriting practice center on manuscript letters L, l, T, t, I, and i, while students also learn the irregular word says. Fluency work during this stage emphasizes phrasing and intonation to support expressive reading. In the following weeks, students explore the multiple jobs of the letter y—as a consonant and as a vowel in different word positions. This includes spelling patterns and irregular words such as busy and business. Handwriting instruction continues with letters J, j, U, u, Y, and y, and fluency development focuses on improving accuracy and self-correction. The module wraps up with instruction on consonant doubling when adding suffixes like – ed, –ing, –er, and –est, reinforcing both spelling and grammar. Students also work with irregular words above and among, practice manuscript letters R, r, N, n, M, and m, and build fluency through enhanced reading rate and automaticity.
