

Into Reading Module 6

Content Area: **Reading**
Course(s): **Reading 2**
Time Period: **January**
Length: **3 weeks**

Module Overview

This phonics module focuses on long vowel sounds formed by vowel teams, helping students recognize and accurately read and spell common vowel patterns. Students begin with vowel teams ai and ay for the /ā/ sound, along with ey and igh. Through focused spelling practice and daily handwriting using letters S, s, F, f, E, e, students strengthen both their decoding and writing fluency. A review of irregular words supports memory retention, while fluency lessons encourage accuracy and self-correction during reading. As the module progresses, students explore additional vowel teams that form the long /ō/ and /ī/ sounds, including ow, oa, oe and ie, igh. These skills are reinforced with spelling practice and targeted handwriting using V, v, W, w, Z, z, X, x, K, and k. Irregular words like both, only, and people are introduced, expanding students' sight word vocabulary. Fluency instruction continues to focus on phrasing, intonation, and reading rate, helping students build confidence and natural expression in their oral reading.
