

# Into Reading Module 12

## Module Overview

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This phonics module focuses on helping students decode complex word structures by exploring silent letter combinations and common prefixes. Students begin by learning to identify and spell words with silent letters such as kn, gn, mb, lm, wr, gh, and digraph ch with alternate pronunciations (/k/, /sh/). This instruction supports accurate decoding and spelling, while handwriting practice emphasizes cursive letters K, k, R, r, S, and s. Irregular words such as tough, rough, and enough are taught to strengthen vocabulary and reinforce reading rate and automaticity.

The module continues with lessons on common prefixes including un-, re-, pre-, allowing students to understand how word meaning can change with these additions. Cursive writing targets B, b, O, o, V, v, X, and x, and fluency work supports accuracy and self-correction. The final section introduces additional prefixes in-, dis-, and mis-, further building students’ morphological awareness. Cursive practice includes M, m, N, n, Y, y, Z, and z, and fluency instruction focuses on phrasing and intonation to enhance reading expression.
