Unit/Module Overview

This phonics module is designed to strengthen foundational literacy skills through an integrated approach that includes phonological awareness, phonics, spelling, handwriting, and fluency. Students will be exposed to practices involving alliteration, rhyme, matching initial sounds and counting syllables. Phonics focus skills will include consonants s, b, n, d, p, c, /k/ and the vowel short /i/. Handwriting skills will focus on vertical, horizontal, slanted lines as well as manuscript writing for letters s, S, b, B, n, N, d, D, i, I, p, P, c, and C. Students will be introduced to irregular words and begin practicing with fluency and self-correction.
