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Statement of Purpose

The purpose of the 21st Century and Careers course is to provide a basic foundation for collaboration, workforce readiness and career exploration skills. The goal of this program is the exposure to career exploration content and resources that will enable learners to transition from school to higher education and/or the workforce effectively. This introduces students to a variety of career opportunities and the skills/education needed for success. In the Sayreville district, the 21st Century Skill lessons are designed to develop basic communication, technological and collaborative skills. An additional focus of this program is the development of the academic, social, and interpersonal skills of each individual student.
