A **singular noun** names only one person, place, or thing. A **plural noun** names more than one person, place, or thing. Most nouns add –s to form the plural. Add –es to a noun that ends with ch, sh, s, ss, or x. When a noun ends in a consonant and y, change the y to i and then add –es.
